## AN ACT

For the relief of Sung Jun Oh.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.

- 2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
- 3 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 4 1101 et seq.), Sung Jun Oh shall be held and considered
- 5 to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for
- 6 permanent residence as of the date of the enactment of
- 7 this Act upon payment of any necessary visa fees.

### 8 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.

- 9 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Sung
- 10 Jun Oh, as provided in this Act, the Secretary of State
- 11 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by one number
- 12 during the current fiscal year the total number of immi-
- 13 grant visas available to natives of the country of the alien's
- 14 birth under section 202(e) of the Immigration and Nation-
- 15 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1152(e)).
