A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain acrylic fiber
tow.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CERTAIN ACRYLIC**
4 **FIBER TOW.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.55.01	Acrylic fiber tow (polyacrylonitrile tow) consisting of 6 subbundles crimped together each containing 45,000 filaments and containing between 2 and 8 percent water, 92 percent acrylonitrile, not more than 0.1 percent zinc, and having an average filament denier of either 1.35 ± 0.08 or 1.2 ± 0.08 (provided for in sub-heading 5501.30.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 2 this section shall apply to goods entered, or withdrawn
 3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
 4 after the date of enactment of this Act.
