## AN ACT

For the relief of the Pottawatomi Nation in Canada for settlement of certain claims against the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## SECTION 1. SETTLEMENT OF CERTAIN CLAIMS.

- 2 (a) AUTHORIZATION FOR PAYMENT.—Subject to sub-
- 3 section (b), the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay to the
- 4 Pottawatomi Nation in Canada, notwithstanding any
- 5 other provision of law, \$1,830,000 from amounts appro-
- 6 priated under section 1304 of title 31, United States Code.
- 7 (b) Payment in Accordance With Stipulation
- 8 FOR RECOMMENDATION OF SETTLEMENT.—The payment
- 9 appropriated under subsection (a) shall be made in accord-
- 10 ance with the terms and conditions of the Stipulation for
- 11 Recommendation of Settlement dated May 22, 2000, en-
- 12 tered into between the Pottawatomi Nation in Canada and
- 13 the United States (in this Act referred to as the "Stipula-
- 14 tion for Recommendation of Settlement") and included in
- 15 the report of the Chief Judge of the United States Court
- 16 of Federal Claims regarding Congressional Reference No.
- 17 94–1037X submitted to the Senate on January 4, 2001,
- 18 pursuant to the provisions of sections 1492 and 2509 of
- 19 title 28, United States Code.
- 20 (c) Full Satisfaction of Claims.—The payment
- 21 made under subsection (a) shall be in full satisfaction of
- 22 all claims of the Pottawatomi Nation in Canada against
- 23 the United States referred to or described in the Stipula-
- 24 tion for Recommendation of Settlement.
- 25 (d) Nonapplicability.—Notwithstanding any other
- 26 provision of law, the Indian Tribal Judgment Funds Use

1 or Distribution Act (25 U.S.C. 1401 et seq.) shall not

2 apply to the payment appropriated under subsection (a).
