Mr. ROCKEFELLER (by request) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs

A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to establish a new Assistant Secretary to perform operations, preparedness, security and law enforcement functions, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Department of Vet-
5 erans Affairs Reorganization Act of 2002”.

6 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES TO TITLE 38, UNITED STATES CODE.**

7 Except as otherwise expressly provided, whenever in
8 this Act an amendment is expressed in terms of an amend-

1 ment to a section or other provision, the reference shall
2 be considered to be made to a section or other provision
3 of title 38, United States Code.

4 **SEC. 3. INCREASE THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED ASSIST-**
5 **ANT SECRETARIES; REVISION OF FUNCTIONS.**

6 Section 308 is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a) by substituting “seven”
8 for “six” in the first sentence; and

9 (2) by adding to the end of subsection (b) the
10 following new paragraph (11):

11 “(11) Operations, preparedness, security and
12 law enforcement functions.”.

13 **SEC. 4. CONFORMING AMENDMENT TO TITLE 5, UNITED**
14 **STATES CODE.**

15 Section 5315 of title 5, United States Code, is
16 amended by changing “Assistant Secretaries, Department
17 of Veterans Affairs (6)” to “Assistant Secretaries, De-
18 partment of Veterans Affairs (7)”.
