To extend the temporary suspension of duty on a certain polymer.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF**
4 **DUTY ON A CERTAIN POLYMER.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by striking heading 9902.39.04 and inserting in
8 numerical sequence the following new heading:

“	9902.39.04	Fluoropolymers containing 95 percent or more by weight of the three monomer units tetrafluoroethylene, hexafluoropropylene, and vinylidene fluoride (provided for in 3904.69.50)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of enactment of this Act.
