#### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Seniors as Volunteers5 in Our Schools Act".

#### 6 SEC. 2. REFERENCES.

7 Except as otherwise specifically provided, whenever in8 this Act an amendment or repeal is expressed in terms
