4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by striking heading 9902.84.20 and inserting in
7 numerical sequence the following new heading:



8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by9 subsection (a) shall apply to goods entered, or withdrawn

- 1 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the date that
- 2 is 15 days after the date of enactment of this Act.
