## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty with respect  
to 2,6, Dichlorotoluene.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. 2,6, DICHLOROTOLUENE.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subheading 9902.32.82 of the  
5 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by striking “12/31/2003” and inserting “12/31/  
7 2006”.

8       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
9 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn

- 1 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
- 2 after the date of enactment of this Act.
