## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on Frescolate (5-Methyl-2-(methylethyl)cyclohexyl alpha-hydroxypropanoate).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FRESCOLATE (5-METHYL-2-**  
4 **(METHYLETHYL)CYCLOHEXYL ALPHA-**  
5 **HYDROXYPROPANOATE).**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
9 new heading:

“	9902.30.79	Frescolate (5-Methyl-2-(methylethyl)cyclohexyl alpha-hydroxypropanoate) (CAS No. 59259-38-0) (provided for in subheading 2918.11.50) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn  
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
