A BILL

To exempt from duty certain entries of peanuts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION FROM DUTIES OF CERTAIN EN-**
4 **TRIES OF PEANUTS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 514 of
6 the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 15144) or any other
7 provision of law, the United States Customs Service
8 shall—

9 (1) relieve the importer of record of all duties,
10 penalties, fines, liquidated damages, and any interest
11 thereon in connection with the entries listed in sub-
12 section (b); and

1 (2) refund any duties, penalties, fines, liq-
 2 uidated damages, or payments made in relation to
 3 such entries, including any interest thereon.
