- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SEC. 101. LIMITATION ON CHILD LABOR.

- 2 (a) In General.—Section 12 of the Fair Labor
- 3 Standards Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. 212) is amended by
- 4 adding at the end the following:
- 5 "(e) No individual under 18 years of age may be em-
- 6 ployed in a position requiring the individual to engage in
- 7 door to door sales or in related support work in a manner
- 8 that requires the individual to remain away from his or
- 9 her permanent residence for more than 24 hours.".
- 10 (b) Rules and Regulations.—The Secretary of
- 11 Labor may issue such rules and regulations as are nec-
- 12 essary to carry out the amendment made by this section,
- 13 consistent with the requirements of chapter 5 of title 5,
- 14 United States Code.
