A BILL

To provide a definition of vehicle for purposes of criminal penalties relating to terrorist attacks and other acts of violence against mass transportation systems.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DEFINITION.**

4 Section 1993(c) of title 18, United States Code, is
 5 amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (7), by striking “and” at the
2 end;

3 (2) in paragraph (8), by striking the period at
4 the end and inserting “; and”; and

5 (3) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(9) the term ‘vehicle’ means any carriage or
7 other contrivance used, or capable of being used, as
8 a means of transportation on land, water, or
9 through the air.”.
