# A BILL

To adjust the indexing of multifamily mortgage limits, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "FHA Multifamily

5 Housing Loan Limit Improvement Act".
