# A BILL

- To require the Secretary of Defense to establish at least one Weapons of Mass Destruction Civil Support Team in each State, and for other purposes.

### **3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Weapons of Mass De-
- 5 struction Civil Support Team Act of 2002".

1	SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF AT LEAST ONE WEAPONS OF
2	MASS DESTRUCTION CIVIL SUPPORT TEAM IN
3	EACH STATE.
4	(a) REQUIREMENT.—The Secretary of Defense shall
5	ensure that there is established, by not later than Sep-
6	tember 30, 2003, at least one Weapons of Mass Destruc-
7	tion Civil Support Team in each State.
8	(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
9	(1) The term "Weapons of Mass Destruction
10	Civil Support Team" means a team that—
11	(A) provides support for emergency pre-
12	paredness programs to prepare for or to re-
13	spond to any emergency involving the use of a
14	weapon of mass destruction (as defined in sec-
15	tion 1403 of the Defense Against Weapons of
16	Mass Destruction Act of 1996 (50 U.S.C.
17	2302)); and
18	(B) is composed of members of National
19	Guard who are performing duties as members
20	of the team under the authority of subsection
21	(c) of section 12310 of title 10, United States
22	Code, while serving on active duty as described
23	in subsection (a) of such section or on full-time
24	National Guard duty under section 502(f) of
25	title 32, United States Code.

(2) The term "State" includes the District of
Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, and
Guam.

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4 (c) FUNDING.—The costs of establishing Weapons of 5 Mass Destruction Civil Support Teams to comply with the requirement in subsection (a), and the costs of training 6 7 and equipping the teams established to comply with such 8 requirement, may be paid (to the extent properly allocable 9 on the bases of purpose and period of availability) out of funds authorized to be appropriated for fiscal year 2003 10 11 for purposes as follows:

- 12 (1) For the Army, for—
- 13 (A) military personnel;
- 14 (B) operation and maintenance;
- 15 (C) other procurement; or
- 16 (D) military construction.
- 17 (2) For the Air Force for military personnel.
- 18 (3) For the Department of Defense for the19 chemical and biological defense program.

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
