A BILL

To amend the Agricultural Adjustment Act to require the Secretary of Agriculture to use the price of feed grains and other cash expenses as factors to determine the basic formula price for milk under milk marketing orders.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BASIC FORMULA PRICE.**

4 Section 8c(5) of the Agricultural Adjustment Act (7
5 U.S.C. 608c(5)), reenacted with amendments by the Agri-
6 cultural Marketing Agreement Act of 1937, is amended
7 by adding at the end the following:

1 “(M) Using as factors to determine the basic formula
2 price for milk under an order issued pursuant to this sec-
3 tion—

4 “(i) the price of feed grains, including the cost
5 of concentrates, byproducts, liquid whey, hay, silage,
6 pasture, and other forage; and

7 “(ii) other cash expenses, including the cost of
8 hauling, artificial insemination, veterinary services
9 and medicine, bedding and litter, marketing, custom
10 services and supplies, fuel, lubrication, electricity,
11 machinery and building repairs, labor, association
12 fees, and assessments.”.
