A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to authorize appropriations for fiscal years 2002 through 2006 to carry out the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “State Criminal Alien
5 Assistance Program Reauthorization Act of 2001”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR FISCAL**
2 **YEARS 2002 THROUGH 2006.**

3 Section 241(i)(5) of the Immigration and Nationality
4 Act (8 U.S.C. 1251(i)(5)) is amended—

5 (1) by striking “and” at the end of subpara-
6 graph (E);

7 (2) by striking the period at the end of sub-
8 paragraph (F) and inserting “; and”; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
10 paragraph:

11 “(G) \$750,000,000 for each of fiscal years
12 2002 through 2006.”.
