A BILL

To reauthorize the supplemental grant for population increases in certain states under the temporary assistance to needy families program for fiscal year 2002.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “TANF Supplemental
3 Grants Act of 2001”.

4 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF TANF SUPPLEMENTAL**
5 **GRANTS FOR POPULATION INCREASES FOR**
6 **FISCAL YEAR 2002.**

7 Section 403(a)(3) of the Social Security Act (42
8 U.S.C. 603(a)(3)) is amended—

9 (1) in subparagraph (A)(ii), by striking “and
10 2001,” and inserting “2001, and 2002,”;

11 (2) in subparagraph (C)(iii), by striking “and
12 2001” and inserting “2001, and 2002”; and

13 (3) in subparagraph (E)—

14 (A) by striking “appropriated for” and in-
15 serting “appropriated—

16 “(i) for”;

17 (B) by striking the period and inserting “;
18 and”;

19 (C) by adding at the end the following:

20 “(ii) for fiscal year 2002, such sums
21 as are necessary for grants under this
22 paragraph.”; and

23 (D) in subparagraph (G), by striking
24 “2001” and inserting “2002”.

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 *This Act may be cited as the “TANF Supplemental*
 3 *Grants Act of 2001”.*

4 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF TANF SUPPLEMENTAL**
 5 **GRANTS FOR POPULATION INCREASES FOR**
 6 **FISCAL YEAR 2002.**

7 *Section 403(a)(3) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.*
 8 *603(a)(3)) is amended by adding at the end the following:*

9 “(H) *REAUTHORIZATION OF GRANTS FOR*
 10 *FISCAL YEAR 2002.—Notwithstanding any other*
 11 *provision of this paragraph—*

12 “(i) *any State that was a qualifying*
 13 *State under this paragraph for fiscal year*
 14 *2001 or any prior fiscal year shall be enti-*
 15 *tled to receive from the Secretary for fiscal*
 16 *year 2002 a grant in an amount equal to*
 17 *the amount required to be paid to the State*
 18 *under this paragraph for the most recent*
 19 *fiscal year in which the State was a quali-*
 20 *fying State;*

21 “(ii) *subparagraph (G) shall be ap-*
 22 *plied as if ‘2002’ were substituted for*
 23 *‘2001’; and*

24 “(iii) *out of any money in the Treas-*
 25 *ury of the United States not otherwise ap-*
 26 *propriated, there are appropriated for fiscal*

1 year 2002 such sums as are necessary for
2 grants under this subparagraph.”.

3 **SEC. 3. FISCAL YEAR 2002 TANF PAYMENTS.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any pay-
5 ment under section 403 of the Social Security Act (42
6 U.S.C. 603) that would otherwise be sent to a State on Sep-
7 tember 30, 2002, by the Secretary of the Treasury shall be
8 sent on October 1, 2002.

9 **SEC. 4. TANF BONUSES FOR HIGH PERFORMANCE STATES.**

10 (a) *RESCISSION*.—Effective upon the date of enactment
11 of this Act or October 1, 2001, whichever is later,
12 \$319,000,000 of the amount appropriated under section
13 403(a)(4)(F) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
14 603(a)(4)(F)) is rescinded.

15 (b) *APPROPRIATION*.—Effective October 1, 2002, out of
16 any money in the Treasury of the United States not other-
17 wise appropriated, there is appropriated \$319,000,000 for
18 bonus grants under section 403(a)(4) of the Social Security
19 Act (42 U.S.C. 603(a)(4)). Amounts appropriated under
20 this subsection shall be in addition to amounts appro-
21 priated under subparagraph (F) of section 403(a)(4) of such
22 Act (42 U.S.C. 603(a)(4)).
