CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 at the close of business on any day from Thursday, May
4 23, 2002, through Saturday, May 25, 2002, or from Tues-
5 day, May 28, 2002, through Friday, May 31, 2002, on
6 a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution
7 by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed
8 or adjourned until 12:00 noon on Monday, June 3, 2002,
9 or Tuesday, June 4, 2002, or until such other time on
10 either of those days as may be specified in the motion to

1 recess or adjourn, or until Members are notified to reas-
2 semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
3 whichever occurs first; and that when the House adjourns
4 on the legislative day of Thursday, May 23, 2002, through
5 Saturday, May 25, 2002, or on any legislative day from
6 Tuesday, May 28, 2002, through Friday, May 31, 2002,
7 on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution
8 by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned
9 until 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 4, 2002, or until Mem-
10 bers are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of
11 this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

12 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
13 Speaker of the House, acting jointly after consultation
14 with the Minority Leader of the Senate and the Minority
15 Leader of the House, shall notify the Members of the Sen-
16 ate and House, respectively, to reassemble at such place
17 and time as they may designate whenever, in their opinion,
18 the public interest shall warrant it.
