Mr. DASCHLE submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 at the close of business on Thursday, June 27, 2002, or
4 Friday, June 28, 2002, on a motion offered pursuant to
5 this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his
6 designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until 12:00 noon
7 on Monday, July 8, 2002, or until such other time on that
8 day as may be specified in the motion to recess or adjourn,
9 or until Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to
10 section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs

1 first; and that when the House adjourns on the legislative
2 day of Thursday, June 27, 2002, Friday, June 28, 2002,
3 or Saturday, June 29, 2002, on a motion offered pursuant
4 to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his
5 designee, it stand adjourned until 2:00 p.m. on Monday,
6 July 8, 2002, or until Members are notified to reassemble
7 pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, which-
8 ever occurs first.

9 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
10 Speaker of the House, acting jointly after consultation
11 with the Minority Leader of the Senate and the Minority
12 Leader of the House, shall notify the Members of the Sen-
13 ate and House, respectively, to reassemble at such place
14 and time as they may designate whenever, in their opinion,
15 the public interest shall warrant it.
