CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To extend the life of the Joint Congressional Committee on Inaugural Ceremonies and the provisions of S. Con. Res. 90 of the One Hundred Sixth Congress.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That effective from January 3, 2001, the
3 joint committee created by Senate Concurrent Resolution
4 89 of the One Hundred Sixth Congress, to make the nec-
5 essary arrangements for the inauguration, is hereby con-
6 tinued with the same power and authority.

7 SEC. 2. That effective from January 3, 2001, the pro-
8 visions of Senate Concurrent Resolution 90 of the One
9 Hundred Sixth Congress, to authorize the rotunda of the

1 United States Capitol to be used in connection with the
2 proceedings and ceremonies for the inauguration of the
3 President-elect and the Vice President-elect of the United
4 States, are hereby continued with the same power and au-
5 thority.
