## RESOLUTION

To authorize representation by the Senate Legal Counsel  
in Aaron Raiser v. Honorable Tom Daschle, et al.

Whereas the Senate, Senator Tom Daschle, and Senator  
Trent Lott have been named as defendants in the case  
of Aaron Raiser v. Honorable Tom Daschle, et al., Case  
No. 01CV894B, now pending in the United States Dis-  
trict Court for the District of Utah; and

Whereas, pursuant to sections 703(a) and 704(a)(1) of the  
Ethics in Government Act of 1978, 2 U.S.C. §§ 288b(a)  
and 288c(a)(1), the Senate may direct its counsel to rep-  
resent the Senate and its Members in civil actions with  
respect to proceedings or actions taken in their official  
capacities: Now, therefore, be it

1        *Resolved*, That the Senate Legal Counsel is author-  
2 ized to represent the Senate, Senator Tom Daschle, and  
3 Senator Trent Lott in the case of Aaron Raiser v. Honor-  
4 able Tom Daschle, et at.
