## RESOLUTION

Eliminating secret Senate holds.

1       *Resolved,*

2       **SECTION 1. ELIMINATING SECRET SENATE HOLDS.**

3       Rule VII of the Standing Rules of the Senate is  
4 amended by adding at the end the following:

5               “7. A Senator who provides notice to party  
6 leadership of his or her intention to object to pro-  
7 ceeding to a motion or matter shall disclose the no-  
8 tice of objection (or hold) in the Congressional  
9 Record in a section reserved for such notices not  
10 later than 2 session days after the date of the no-  
11 tice.”.
