CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the Capitol Grounds for activities associated with the dedication of the National World War II Memorial.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

1 **SEC. 5. ENFORCEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS.**

2 The Capitol Police Board shall provide for enforce-
3 ment of the restrictions contained in section 4 of the Act
4 of July 31, 1946 (40 U.S.C. 5104(c); 60 Stat. 718), con-
5 cerning sales, advertisements, displays, and solicitations
6 on the Capitol Grounds, as well as other restrictions appli-
7 cable to the Capitol Grounds, with respect to the event
8 to be carried out under this resolution.
