Mr. EHLERS submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was
considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of
Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment
of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Saturday, November 20, 2004, it stand ad-
4 journed until 2 p.m. on Monday, December 6, 2004, or
5 until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of
6 this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and that
7 when the Senate recesses or adjourns on Saturday, No-
8 vember 20, 2004, it stand recessed or adjourned until
9 noon on Monday, December 6, 2004, or Tuesday, Decem-
10 ber 7, 2004, or until such other time on either of those

1 days as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his
2 designee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until the
3 time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this con-
4 current resolution, whichever occurs first.

5 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
6 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
7 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
8 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
9 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
10 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-
11 ignate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall
12 warrant it.
