Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate 2 *concurring*), That when the House adjourns on the legislative day of Saturday, November 20, 2004, it stand ad-3 4 journed until 2 p.m. on Monday, December 6, 2004, or 5 until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and that 6 7 when the Senate recesses or adjourns on Saturday, No-8 vember 20, 2004, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Monday, December 6, 2004, or Tuesday, Decem-9 10 ber 7, 2004, or until such other time on either of those

days as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his
designee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until the
time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this con current resolution, whichever occurs first.

5 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting 6 7 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify 8 9 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-10 11 ignate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall 12 warrant it.
