CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for the sine die adjournment of the second session of the One Hundred Eighth Congress.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on any legisla-
3 tive day from Tuesday, December 7, 2004, through Fri-
4 day, December 10, 2004, on a motion offered pursuant
5 to this concurrent resolution by its majority leader or his
6 designee, it stand adjourned sine die, or until the time of
7 any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent
8 resolution; and that when the Senate adjourns on any day
9 from Tuesday, December 7, 2004, through Saturday, De-
10 cember 11, 2004, on a motion offered pursuant to this

1 concurrent resolution by its majority leader or his des-
2 ignee, it stand adjourned sine die, or until the time of any
3 reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolu-
4 tion.

5 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the majority
6 leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
7 jointly after consultation with the minority leader of the
8 House and the minority leader of the Senate, shall notify
9 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
10 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-
11 ignate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall
12 warrant it.
