Mr. YOUNG of Florida introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Appropriations

## JOINT RESOLUTION

Making further continuing appropriations for the fiscal year 2004, and for other purposes.

1        *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2        *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3        That Public Law 108–84 is amended by striking the date  
4        specified in section 107(c) and inserting “November 7,  
5        2003”.

6        SEC. 2. Public Law 108–84 is further amended as  
7        follows:

8                (1) In section 103, by inserting “(a)” after the  
9        section designation and by adding at the end the fol-  
10        lowing new subsection:

1           “(b) For purposes of section 101, the term ‘rate for  
2 operations not exceeding the current rate’ has the meaning  
3 given such term (including supplemental appropriations  
4 and rescissions) in the attachments to Office of Manage-  
5 ment and Budget Bulletin No. 03–05 entitled ‘Apportion-  
6 ment of the Continuing Resolution(s) for Fiscal Year  
7 2004’.”.

8           (2) In section 125, by inserting before the pe-  
9 riod at the end the following:

10 “: *Provided*, That such amounts as may be necessary for  
11 administrative expenses of the Grants-in-aid for Airports  
12 program shall be available to the Secretary of Transpor-  
13 tation out of the Airport and Airway Trust Fund at a rate  
14 for operations not exceeding the current rate and for  
15 which authority was made available under the Department  
16 of Transportation and Related Agencies Appropriations  
17 Act, 2003”.

18           (3) By striking sections 126 through 130 and  
19 by redesignating sections 131 through 135 as sec-  
20 tions 126 through 130, respectively.

21           (4) In section 127, as so redesignated, by strik-  
22 ing “through 130, and section 134,” and inserting  
23 “and 129”.

24           SEC. 3. Section 8144(b) of the Department of De-  
25 fense Appropriations Act, 2003 (Public Law 107–248), as

1 amended by Public Law 108–84, is further amended by  
2 striking “October 31, 2003” and inserting “November 7,  
3 2003”.
