3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON THE DEPARTMENT OF DE-**
4 **FENSE PARTICIPATION IN AIR SHOWS IN**
5 **FRANCE THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2007.**

6 (a) PROHIBITION.—During the period beginning on
7 the date of the enactment of this Act and ending on De-
8 cember 31, 2007, the Secretary of Defense may not au-

1 thorize or permit participation in any form by any element
2 of the Department of Defense in any international aviation
3 trade exhibition (known as an “air show”) to be held in
4 France.

5 (b) INCLUSION OF SUPPORT FOR CONTRACTORS.—
6 The prohibition in subsection (a) includes support in any
7 form to any defense contractor, industrial association, or
8 other entity that is participating in any such international
9 aviation trade exhibition.
