- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Wildfire Response En-

1 SEC. 2. ACQUISITION OF GOODS AND SERVICES RELATED

- 2 **TO FIGHTING WILDFIRES.**
- 3 The Secretary of Agriculture and the Secretary of the
- 4 Interior may place an order with any Federal agency for
- 5 goods or services directly related to fighting wildfires with-
- 6 out regard to the restriction contained in section
- 7 1535(a)(4) of title 31, United States Code, if the Sec-
- 8 retary placing the order determines that the goods or serv-
- 9 ices are necessary to properly respond to a wildfire in a
- 10 timely and effective manner.
