- 3 (a) Repeal.—Section 801 of the Act entitled "An
- 4 Act to increase the revenue, and for other purposes", ap-
- 5 proved September 8, 1916 (15 U.S.C. 72), is repealed.
- 6 (b) Effect of Repeal.—The repeal made by sub-
- 7 section (a) shall not affect any action under section 801
- 8 of the Act referred to in subsection (a) that was com-
- 9 menced before the date of the enactment of this Act and
- 10 is pending on such date.
