## A BILL

To repeal section 801 of the Revenue Act of 1916.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF ANTIDUMPING PROVISION OF REV-**  
2 **ENUE ACT OF 1916.**

3 (a) REPEAL.—Section 801 of the Act entitled “An  
4 Act to increase the revenue, and for other purposes”, ap-  
5 proved September 8, 1916 (15 U.S.C. 72), is repealed.

6 (b) EFFECT OF REPEAL.—The repeal made by sub-  
7 section (a) shall not affect any action under section 801  
8 of the Act referred to in subsection (a) that was com-  
9 menced before the date of the enactment of this Act and  
10 is pending on such date.
