Mr. KING of New York introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to reauthorize the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SCAAP REAUTHORIZED.**

4 Section 241(i) of the Immigration and Nationality
5 Act (8 U.S.C. 1231(i)) is amended—

6 (1) by amending paragraph (4)(A) to read as
7 follows:

8 “(4)(A) In carrying out paragraph (1), the Sec-
9 retary of Homeland Security shall give priority to—

1 “(i) Federal incarceration of undocu-
2 mented criminal aliens who have committed ag-
3 gravated felonies; and

4 “(ii) compensating States, and political
5 subdivisions of States—

6 “(I) located on a border of the United
7 States with Canada or Mexico; or

8 “(II) having one of the fifth largest
9 populations of aliens who are not author-
10 ized to be present in the United States.”;

11 and

12 (2) by amending paragraph (5) to read as fol-
13 lows:

14 “(5) There are authorized to be appropriated
15 such sums as may be necessary to carry out this
16 subsection for each of fiscal years 2004 through
17 2008.”.
