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## AN ACT

To amend the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to participate in the Williamson County, Texas, Water Recycling and Reuse Project, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROJECT AUTHORIZATION.**

4 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This section may be cited as the  
5 “Williamson County Water Recycling Act of 2003”.

6 (b) IN GENERAL.—The Reclamation Wastewater and  
7 Groundwater Study and Facilities Act (Title XVI of Pub-  
8 lic Law 102–575; 43 U.S.C. 390h et seq.) is amended by  
9 inserting after section 1635 the following new section:

10 **“SEC. 1636. WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TEXAS, WATER RECY-**  
11 **CLING AND REUSE PROJECT.**

12 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
13 tion with the Lower Colorado River Authority, Texas, is  
14 authorized to participate in the design, planning, and con-  
15 struction of permanent facilities to reclaim and reuse  
16 water in Williamson County, Texas.

17 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the costs  
18 of the project described in subsection (a) shall not exceed  
19 25 percent of the total cost.

20 “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
21 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
22 described in subsection (a).”.

23 **SEC. 2. CLERICAL AMENDMENT.**

24 The table of sections in section 2 of the Reclamation  
25 Projects Authorization and Adjustment Act of 1992 is

1 amended by inserting after the item relating to section  
2 1635 the following:

“Sec. 1636. Williamson County, Texas, Water Recycling and Reuse Project.”.
