Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. PAYMENT OF SELECTED RESERVE REENLIST
MENT BONUS TO MEMBERS OF SELECTED RE
SERVE WHO ARE MOBILIZED.

Section 308b of title 37, United States Code, is

amended—

(1) by redesignating subsections (d), (e), and

(f) as subsections (e), (f), and (g), respectively; and

1 (2) by inserting after subsection (c) the fol2 lowing new subsection (d):
3 "(d) PAYMENT TO MOBILIZED MEMBERS.—In the
4 case of a member entitled to a bonus under this section
5 who is called or ordered to active duty, any amount of
6 such bonus that is payable to the member during the pe7 riod of active duty of the member shall be paid the mem8 ber during that period of active duty, notwithstanding the
9 service of the member on active duty pursuant to such
