A BILL

1 **SECTION 1. NAME OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS**

2 **HEALTH CARE FACILITY, CHICAGO, ILLINOIS.**

3 The Department of Veterans Affairs health care facil-
4 ity located at 820 South Damen Avenue in Chicago, Illi-
5 nois, shall after the date of the enactment of this Act be
6 known and designated as the “Jesse Brown Department
7 of Veterans Affairs Medical Center”. Any reference to
8 such facility in any law, map, regulation, document, paper,
9 or other record of the United States shall be considered
10 to be a reference to the Jesse Brown Department of Vet-
11 erans Affairs Medical Center.
