## A BILL

To amend Public Law 89–366 to allow for an adjustment in the number of free roaming horses permitted in Cape Lookout National Seashore.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2       tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. ADJUSTMENT IN THE NUMBER OF FREE ROAM-  
4       ING HORSES PERMITTED IN CAPE LOOKOUT  
5       NATIONAL SEASHORE, NC.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—The first subsection (b) of section  
7       5 of Public Law 89–366 (16 U.S.C. 459g–4) is amend-  
8       ed—

9               (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “100 free  
10       roaming horses” and inserting “not less than 110

1 free roaming horses, with a target population of be-  
2 tween 120 and 130 free roaming horses,”;

3 (2) in paragraph (3), by striking subparagraph  
4 (B) and inserting the following new subparagraph:

5 “(B) unless removal is carried out as part of a  
6 plan to maintain the viability of the herd; or”; and

7 (3) in paragraph (5), by striking “100” and in-  
8 serting “110”.

9 (b) REPEAL OF DUPLICATE SUBSECTIONS.—Section  
10 5 of Public Law 89–366 is amended—

11 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “(a)” after  
12 “(a)”; and

13 (2) by striking the second subsection (b).
