## A BILL

To provide a cost-sharing requirement for the construction of the Arkansas Valley Conduit in the State of Colorado.

COST-SHARING REQUIREMENT FOR THE AR-4 **KANSAS VALLEY CONDUIT IN THE STATE OF** 5 COLORADO. (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 7 of Public Law 87–590 6 7 (76 Stat. 393) is amended8 (1) by striking "SEC. 7." and inserting the fol-9 lowing: "SEC. 7. AUTHORIZATION OF APPRO-10 **PRIATIONS.**";

1	(2) in the first sentence, by striking "There is
2	hereby authorized" and inserting the following:
3	"(a) CONSTRUCTION.—There is authorized";
4	(3) in the second sentence, by striking "There
5	are also" and inserting the following:
6	"(b) Operations and Maintenance.—There are";
7	and
8	(4) by adding at the end the following:
9	"(c) Arkansas Valley Conduit.—
10	"(1) IN GENERAL.—There are authorized to be
11	appropriated such sums as are necessary to pay the
12	Federal share of the costs of constructing the Ar-
13	kansas Valley Conduit in accordance with subsection
14	(a) of the first section, which Federal share shall be
15	nonreimbursable.
16	"(2) Non-federal share.—
17	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The non-Federal
18	share of the total costs of construction (includ-
19	ing design and engineering costs) of the Arkan-
20	sas Valley Conduit shall be not more than $25$
21	percent.
22	"(B) FORM.—Up to 100 percent of the
23	non-Federal share may be in the form of in-
24	kind contributions.".

(b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub section (a) apply to any costs of constructing the Arkansas
Valley Conduit incurred during fiscal year 2002 or any
subsequent fiscal year.
