- To amend the Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002 to enhance the ability of oilseed producers to use oilseed base acres for the production of fruits and vegetables.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Farming Flexibility
 - 5 Act of 2003".

1 SEC. 2. PRODUCTION OF FRUITS AND VEGETABLES FOR

- 2 PROCESSING ON OILSEED BASE ACRES.
- 3 (a) Effect on Oilseed Base Acres Calcula-
- 4 TION.—Section 1101 of the Farm Security and Rural In-
- 5 vestment Act of 2002 (7 U.S.C. 7911) is amended by add-
- 6 ing at the end the following new subsection:
- 7 "(i) CALCULATION OF OILSEED BASE ACRES.—Effec-
- 8 tive on the date of the enactment of this subsection, the
- 9 planting, prevented planting, or production of fruits or
- 10 vegetables for processing shall be deemed to be the same
- 11 as the planting, prevented planting, or production of oil-
- 12 seeds for purposes of the calculation of oilseed base
- 13 acres.".
- 14 (b) Planting Flexibility.—Section 1106 of such
- 15 Act (7 U.S.C. 7916) is amended by adding at the end the
- 16 following new subsection:
- 17 "(e) Production of Fruits and Vegetables for
- 18 Processing.—Effective on the date of the enactment of
- 19 this subsection, a fruit or vegetable for processing may
- 20 be produced on oilseed base acres, except that direct pay-
- 21 ments and counter-cyclical payments for oilseeds shall be
- 22 reduced by an acre for each acre planted to the fruit or
- 23 vegetable.".
