A BILL

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN EXPENSES OF RURAL LETTER CAR-4

RIERS.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 162(o) of the Internal 6 Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to treatment of certain reimbursed expenses of rural mail carriers) is amended by 7

redesignating paragraph (2) as paragraph (3) and by in serting after paragraph (1) the following:

3 "(2) Special rule where expenses exceed 4 **REIMBURSEMENTS.**—Notwithstanding paragraph 5 (1)(A), if the expenses incurred by an employee for 6 the use of a vehicle in performing services described 7 in paragraph (1) exceed the qualified reimburse-8 ments for such expenses, such excess shall be taken 9 into account in computing the miscellaneous itemized deductions of the employee under section 10 67." 11

12 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The heading for
13 section 162(o) of such Code is amended by striking "RE14 IMBURSED".

(c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
December 31, 2003.

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
