To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to improve access to advanced practice nurses under the Medicaid Program.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Medicaid Nursing In-
- 5 centive Act of 2003".

13	(b) Fee-For-Service Program.—Section
14	1905(a)(21) of such Act (42 U.S.C. $1396d(a)(21)$) is

- 10 (d) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 11 this section shall apply to items and services furnished in
- 12 calendar quarters beginning on or after 90 days after the
- 13 date of the enactment of this Act, without regard to
- 14 whether or not final regulations to carry out such amend-
- 15 ments have been promulgated by such date.
