## **AN ACT**

To provide that the actuarial value of the prescription drug benefits offered to Medicare eligible enrollees by a plan under the Federal employees health benefits program shall be at least equal to the actuarial value of the prescription drug benefits offered by such plan to its enrollees generally. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 SECTION 1. NEGOTIATIONS BY THE OFFICE OF PERSONNEL
 MANAGEMENT.

5 Section 8902 of title 5, United States Code, is6 amended by adding at the end the following:

7 "(p)(1) A contract may not be made or a plan ap8 proved which does not offer to Medicare eligible enrollees
9 prescription drug benefits the actuarial value of which is
10 at least equal to the actuarial value of the prescription
11 drug benefits which are offered to enrollees under the plan
12 generally.

"(2) For purposes of this subsection, the Director of
the Office of Personnel Management shall establish processes and methods for determining the actuarial value of
prescription drug benefits.".

## 17 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

18 The amendment made by section 1 shall apply with19 respect to contract years beginning after the date of enact-20 ment of this Act.
