## A BILL

To amend the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act to make New York a member of the New England Fishery Management Council.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “New York Fair Fishing  
5 Act of 2003”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADDITION OF NEW YORK TO NEW ENGLAND FISH-**  
2 **ERY MANAGEMENT COUNCIL.**

3 Section 302(a)(1)(A) of the Magnuson-Stevens Fish-  
4 ery Conservation and Management Act (16 U.S.C.  
5 1852(a)(1)(A)) is amended—

6 (1) by inserting “New York,” after “New  
7 Hampshire,”;

8 (2) by striking “except” and inserting “except  
9 New York, and except”;

10 (3) by striking “17” and inserting “20”; and

11 (4) by striking “11” and inserting “13”.
