- 4 This Act may be cited as the "New York Fair Fishing
- 5 Act of 2003".

ADDITION OF NEW YORK TO NEW ENGLAND FISH-2 ERY MANAGEMENT COUNCIL. 3 Section 302(a)(1)(A) of the Magnuson-Stevens Fish-4 ery Conservation and Management Act (16 U.S.C. 1852(a)(1)(A)) is amended— 5 (1) by inserting "New York," after "New 6 7 Hampshire,"; (2) by striking "except" and inserting "except 8 New York, and except"; 9 (3) by striking "17" and inserting "20"; and 10 (4) by striking "11" and inserting "13". 11
