A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to extend to additional military retirees with service-connected disabilities the special compensation authority provided for certain retirees with combat-related disabilities.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to continue the process
- 5 of enactment, through an incremental approach, of the
- 6 elimination of the requirement, in the case of a retired
- 7 member of the uniformed services who has a service-con-
- 8 nected disability, of the offset of that member's military

1	retired pay by the amount of disability compensation that
2	member receives from the Department of Veterans Af-
3	fairs, with the eventual goal of providing for such a mem-
4	ber full concurrent receipt of the member's retired pay and
5	veterans' disability compensation.
6	SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF SPECIAL COMPENSATION PAYMENT
7	AUTHORITY FOR MILITARY RETIREES WITH
8	SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITIES.
9	(a) Repeal of Limitation to Combat-Related
10	DISABILITIES.—Section 1413a of title 10, United States
11	Code, is amended—
12	(1) by striking "combat-related" each place it
13	appears in subsection (a), (b), (c), and (d); and
14	(2) in subsection (e)—
15	(A) by striking "Combat-Related" in
16	the subsection heading;
17	(B) by striking "combat-related" in the
18	matter preceding paragraph (1); and
19	(C) by striking paragraph (2) and insert-
20	ing the following:
21	"(2) A service-connected disability that is rated
22	as not less than 50 percent disabling—
23	"(A) by the Secretary concerned, as of the
24	date on which the member is retired from the

1	uniformed services, under criteria prescribed by
2	the Secretary of Defense; or
3	"(B) by the Secretary of Veterans Af-
4	fairs.".
5	(b) Clerical Amendments.—(1) The heading of
6	such section is amended to read as follows:
7	"§ 1413a. Special compensation for certain disabled
8	uniformed services retirees ".
9	(2) The item relating to such section in the table of
10	sections at the beginning of such section is amended to
11	read as follows:
	"1413a. Special compensation for certain disabled uniformed services retirees.".
12	(c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
13	subsection (a) shall apply with respect to payments of spe-
14	cial compensation under section 1413a of title 10, United
15	States Code, as amended by subsection (a), payable for
