A BILL

- To authorize the Surface Transportation Board to direct the continued operation of certain commuter rail passenger transportation operations in emergency situations, and for other purposes.

 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Emergency Directed

5 Rail Service Act".

6 SEC. 2. FAILURE OF COMMUTER OPERATIONS.

7 Section 11123 of title 49, United States Code, is8 amended—

1	(1) in subsection (a)—
2	(A) by inserting "failure of existing com-
3	muter rail passenger transportation operations
4	caused by a cessation of service by the National
5	Railroad Passenger Corporation," after "ces-
6	sation of operations,";
7	(B) by striking "or" at the end of para-
8	graph (3);
9	(C) by striking the period at the end of
10	paragraph (4)(C) and inserting "; or"; and
11	(D) by adding at the end the following new
12	paragraph:
13	"(5) in the case of a failure of existing freight
14	or commuter rail passenger transportation oper-
15	ations caused by a cessation of service by the Na-
16	tional Railroad Passenger Corporation, direct the
17	continuation of the operations and dispatching,
18	maintenance, and other necessary infrastructure
19	functions related to the operations.";
20	(2) in subsection (b)(3)—
21	(A) by striking "When" and inserting "(A)
22	Except as provided in subparagraph (B),
23	when"; and
24	(B) by adding at the end the following new
25	subparagraph:

"(B) In the case of a failure of existing freight or 1 2 commuter rail passenger transportation operations caused by a cessation of service by the National Railroad Pas-3 4 senger Corporation, the Board shall provide funding to 5 fully reimburse the directed service provider for its costs associated with the activities directed under subsection 6 7 (a), including the payment of increased insurance pre-8 miums. The Board shall order complete indemnification 9 against any and all claims associated with the provision 10 of service to which the directed rail carrier may be ex-11 posed.";

12 (3) by adding the following new paragraph at13 the end of subsection (c):

14 "(4) In the case of a failure of existing freight or 15 commuter rail passenger transportation operations caused 16 by cessation of service by the National Railroad Passenger 17 Corporation, the Board may not direct a rail carrier to 18 undertake activities under subsection (a) to continue such 19 operations unless—

"(A) the Board first affirmatively finds that the
rail carrier is operationally capable of conducting the
directed service in a safe and efficient manner; and
"(B) the funding for such directed service required by subparagraph (B) of subsection (b)(3) is
provided in advance in appropriations Acts."; and

(4) by adding at the end the following new sub sections:

3 "(e) For purposes of this section, the National Rail4 road Passenger Corporation and any entity providing com5 muter rail passenger transportation shall be considered
6 rail carriers subject to the Board's jurisdiction.

7 "(f) For purposes of this section, the term "com8 muter rail passenger transportation" has the meaning
9 given that term in section 24102(4).".

10 SEC. 3. CONFORMING AMENDMENT.

Section 24301(c) of title 49, United States Code, is
amended by inserting "11123," after "except for sections".

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
