A BILL

To amend the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 to provide for greater efficiency at the Occupational Safety and Health Review Commission.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. 4 This Act may be cited as the "Occupational Safety and Health Review Commission Efficiency Act of 2004". SEC. 2. OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH REVIEW COM-6 7 MISSION. 8 (a) Amendments.—Section 12 of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (29 U.S.C. 661) is amended 10 as follows:
- 11 (1) In subsection (a), by striking the word 12 "three" and inserting in lieu thereof, the word "five" 13 and by inserting the word "legal" before the word 14 "training".
 - (2) In subsection (b) by striking all after the words "except that" and inserting in lieu thereof: "the President may extend the term of a member for no more than 365 consecutive days to allow a continuation in service at the pleasure of the President after the expiration of that member's term until a successor nominated by the President has been confirmed to serve. Any vacancy caused by the death, resignation, or removal of a member before the expiration of a term, for which he or she was appointed shall be filled only for the remainder of such expired term. - 4 (b) New Positions.—Of the two vacancies for mem-
