A BILL

 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Savannah River Lakes
 - 5 Private Land Ownership Restoration Act".
 - 6 SEC. 2. CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN LAND IN GEORGIA.
 - 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the
 - 8 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Army
 - 9 shall transfer the land described in subsection (b), without

1	consideration, by quitclaim deed, all right, title, and inter-
2	est in such land to each county that has within its bound-
3	aries the land in subsection (b).
4	(b) Land Description.—The land referred to in
5	subsection (a) is as follows:
6	(1) J. STROM THURMOND DAM AND LAKE.—
7	Land owned by the Corps of Engineers that con-
8	stitutes the J. Strom Thurmond Dam and Lake
9	project that is—
10	(A) 330 feet above mean sea level; and
11	(B) within the boundaries of—
12	(i) McDuffie, Wilkes, Elbert, Colum-
13	bia, and Lincoln Counties, Georgia; and
14	(ii) of McCormick and Abbeville Coun-
15	ties, South Carolina.
16	(2) RICHARD B. RUSSELL DAM AND LAKE.—
17	Land owned by the Corps of Engineers that con-
18	stitutes the Richard B. Russell Dam and Lake
19	project that is—
20	(A) 475 feet above mean sea level; and
21	(B) within the boundaries of—
22	(i) Elbert County, Georgia; and
23	(ii) Abbeville and Anderson Counties,
24	South Carolina.

1	(3) Hartwell dam and lake.—Land owned
2	by the Corps of Engineers that constitutes the
3	Hartwell Dam and Lake project that—
4	(A) is 660 feet above mean sea level;
5	(B) within the boundaries of—
6	(i) Hart, Franklin, and Stevens Coun-
7	ties, Georgia; and
8	(ii) Anderson and Oconee Counties,
9	South Carolina.
10	(e) Survey to Obtain Legal Description.—The
11	exact acreage and the legal description of the real property
12	described in subsection (b) shall be determined by a survey
13	that is satisfactory to the Secretary of the Army.
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
