## A BILL

To amend the Hmong Veterans' Naturalization Act of 2000 to extend the deadlines for application and payment of fees.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Bruce Vento Hmong  
5       Veterans’ Naturalization Act of 2003”.

6       **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF DEADLINES.**

7       Section 6 of the Hmong Veterans’ Naturalization Act  
8       of 2000 (8 U.S.C. 1423 note) (as amended by section 112  
9       of Public Law 107–77 (115 Stat. 765)) is amended—

1           (1) by striking “36 months after the date of the  
2       enactment of this Act” and inserting “18 months  
3       after the date of the enactment of the Bruce Vento  
4       Hmong Veterans’ Naturalization Act of 2003”; and  
5           (2) by striking “36 months after the date of the  
6       enactment of this sentence” and inserting “18  
7       months after the date of the enactment of the Bruce  
8       Vento Hmong Veterans’ Naturalization Act of  
9       2003”.
