- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 That the following sums are appropriated, out of any
- 4 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the
- 5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2003, namely:
- 6 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY
- 7 EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE
- 8 DISASTER RELIEF
- 9 For an additional amount for "Disaster Relief" for
- 10 necessary expenses in carrying out the functions of the

- 1 Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assist-
- 2 ance Act (42 U.S.C. 5121 et seq.), \$983,600,000, to re-
- 3 main available until expended: Provided, That this amount
- 4 is designated by the Congress as an emergency require-
- $5\,$ ment pursuant to section 502 of H. Con. Res. 95 (108th
- 6 Congress), the concurrent resolution on the budget for fis-
- 7 cal year 2004.
- 8 This Act may be cited as the "Emergency Supple-
- 9 mental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Act, 2003".
