Making emergency supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2003.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That the following sums are appropriated, out of any

- 1 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the
- 2 fiscal year ending September 30, 2003, namely:
- 3 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY
- 4 EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE
- 5 Disaster Relief
- 6 For an additional amount for "Disaster Relief" for
- 7 necessary expenses in carrying out the functions of the
- 8 Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assist-
- 9 ance Act (42 U.S.C. 5121 et seq.), \$983,600,000, to re-
- 10 main available until expended: *Provided*, That this amount
- 11 is designated by the Congress as an emergency require-
- 12 ment pursuant to section 502 of H. Con. Res. 95 (108th
- 13 Congress), the concurrent resolution on the budget for fis-
- 14 cal year 2004.
- 15 This Act may be cited as the "Emergency Supple-
- 16 mental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Act, 2003".
